

Indications

- Insufficient vaginal lubrication
- Discomfort from recurrent infections
- Changes in the appearance and tone of the labia majora
- A feeling of tension or burning
- Vaginal discomfort or pain
- Enhancing the shape, size, and symmetry of the labia majora
- Correcting postpartum scars

Description of the procedure

Approximately 1-2ml of hyaluronic acid preparation is injected into the subcutaneous tissue of the labia minora, which strongly binds water and thus restores the normal volume and hydration of the labia minora.

Postoperative recommendations

After the procedure, the patient can lead a normal lifestyle. For 1-2 weeks, high pressure on the treated area should be avoided - so you should give up horseback riding or cycling, for example. Postoperative swelling usually subsides after 2-3 days.

Contraindications

- Skin lesions of the vulva requiring prior histopathological verification
- Inflammation of the vulva
- Symptoms of a cold
- Herpes
- Pregnancy

For a few days, the injection sites may be slightly sore or there may be a slight swelling. These symptoms disappear after 2-3 days.
