

Composition/Action

- **Snail mucus filtrate** - the unique composition of the mucus is ideal for all skin types. Snail mucus influences the internal regeneration of cells and the external condition of the skin: it eliminates flakiness of the epidermis, evens out the skin tone, promotes the healing of inflammation. Snail mucus extract maintains skin elasticity, moisturizes and nourishes the skin, has an anti-inflammatory effect, protects against premature aging.
- **Betaine** - a natural amino acid with moisturizing and soothing properties. It soothes irritation on the skin, such as after chemical peels, protects cell membranes and binds water on the surface of the epidermis, hence its moisturizing properties.
- **Allantoin** - has soothing and calming properties for irritated skin. Stimulates the growth of healthy tissue, directly promoting skin regeneration. It has moisturizing, softening and anti-inflammatory properties. It makes the skin smooth and relaxed.
- **Hyaluronic acid** - has a smoothing effect, visibly improves skin firmness and elasticity.
- **Patchouli extract** - has an anti-allergic and anti-inflammatory effect. Increases the skin's resistance to infections, free radicals, allergens and toxins from the environment. Has a regenerative effect - accelerates wound healing. Prevents plugging of the sebaceous gland mouths and formation of blackheads. It also inhibits excessive keratinization of the skin. It contributes to increasing and accelerating the synthesis of collagen and elastin, while increasing the elasticity and firmness of the skin. It has an anti-wrinkle effect. Soothes and numbs irritated and itchy skin. Recommended for dry, flaky, atopic, sensitive, mature, but also oily skin prone to pollution.
- **Kudzu root** - has antiseptic, regulating and calming properties, bringing balance to the human body.

Precautions

Avoid use on irritated skin. In case of redness, discontinue use. Avoid direct contact with eyes. If it gets into your eyes, rinse immediately with abundant water. Keep out of reach of children.
